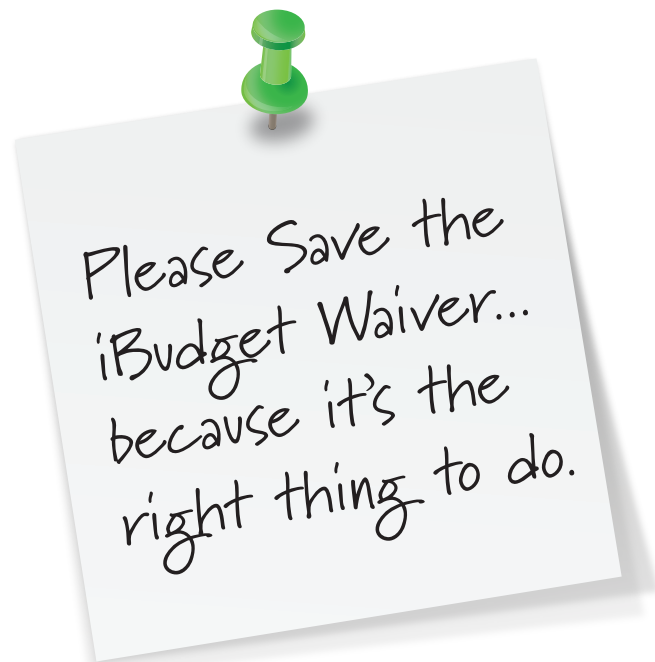
Such services, including personal care, are critical for the survival of **thousands of Floridians**.
